GOVERNING ELDERS

Elders are elected by the congregation to lead the church in life and mission. They are mature followers of Jesus who together seek to understand and do God's will by equipping, teaching, and encouraging all the members of the church. There are two kinds of elders, **Governing Elders** and **Parish Elders**.

GOVERNING ELDERS serve for a short term (three years) in overseeing and leading the direction of the church. Acting in unity together they are called "the Session," trusting that God gives wisdom and direction to the gathered body of elders beyond what he does with them as individuals. They guide the church in strategic planning, stimulating generosity, leadership development, and oversee finances and personnel.
