FINANCIAL UPDATE

As we begin to close out 2021 and prepare our budget for 2022, we want to share with our church family how the Lord is providing for our finances this year.

Due to many contributing factors, we are currently in a situation where we are about \$117K behind in giving revenue for what we projected at this point in the year. While our staff has curtailed many of our ministry expenses at 33% below budget YTD, our operating expenses are 7.9% over budget, mostly because of the heavy technology budget we have had to levy in order to make our worship accessible virtually, and also because of higher than anticipated facility expenses. Therefore, due to lost donors and heavy expenses incurred this year, we are projecting to suffer a \$310K shortfall by year end.

By God's grace, we ended last year with a significant surplus, so we have cash reserves sufficient to cover the shortfall at the end of this year. But this shortfall is expected to continue into 2022, and Session is currently working on a plan for how we will operate within a lower budget for the coming year.

WHAT ARE WE ASKING OF YOU?

Pray for God's provision for our church, and that the work of ministry and mission that he desires for us would be accomplished. If you are currently giving to our church, thank you and please continue to do so! If God has especially prospered you over the past 18 months, would you consider giving generously toward making up this end-of-year shortfall?

As Paul wrote, "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God" (Philippians 4:6). This is a moment we can depend on our Father, and give thanks that he is giving us an opportunity to look to him for our need!
