- » Blessing, glory, wisdom, thanks, honor, power, and strength be to our God forevermore!


PRAYER OF ADORATION

SONG OF PRAISE | "PRAISE TO THE LORD, THE ALMIGHTY"



SCRIPTURE READING | EPHESIANS 1:15-23
